LETTER OF APPOINTMENT FOR INDEPENDENT DIRECTORS

We confirm our decision to appoint you on the Board of Directors of Empee Sugars and Chemicals Limited (hereinafter referred to as ESCL or the Company) with effect from 09.5.2016. This letter of appointment sets out the terms and conditions covering your appointment which are as follows:

1. Appointment

- 1.1 You will be appointed as a Non-Executive Independent Director on the Board of Directors of ESCL with effect from 09.5.2016. Your appointment is also subject to the maximum permissible Directorships that one can hold as per the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the SEBI (LODR) Regulations, and the Company hereby satisfies to this provision.
- 1.2 The term Independent Director should be construed as defined under the Companies Act, 2013 and the listing agreement.
- 1.3 The Company has adopted the provisions with respect to appointment and tenure of Independent Directors which is consistent with the Companies Act, 2013 and the SEBI (LODR) Regulations. Accordingly, the Independent Directors will serve for not more than two terms of five years each on the Board of the Company. The Company is at liberty to disengage Non Executive Independent Director earlier subject to compliance of relevant provisions of Companies Act, 2013.

2. Committees

The Board of Directors (the Board) may, if it deems fit, invite you for being appointed on one or more existing Board Committees or any such Committee that is set up in the future. Your appointment on such Committee(s) will be subject to the applicable regulations, and your acceptance.

3. Time Commitment

3.1 As a Non-Executive Director you are expected to bring objectivity and independence of view to the Board's discussions and to help provide the Board with effective leadership in relation to the Company's strategy, performance, and risk management as well as ensuring high standards of financial probity and corporate governance. You are expected to attend Board, Board Committees to which you may be appointed and Shareholders meetings and to devote such time to your duties, as appropriate for you to discharge your duties effectively. Ordinarily, all meetings are held in Chennai.

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3.2 By accepting this appointment, you confirm that you are able to allocate sufficient time to meet the expectations from your role to the satisfaction of the Board.

4. Role and Duties

People: Non-Executive Independent Directors are responsible for determining appropriate levels of remuneration of Executive Directors and have a prime role in appointing, assist and where necessary, removing Executive Directors and in succession planning;

Reporting: Non-Executive Independent Directors take responsibility for the processes for accurately reporting on performance and the financial position of ESCL; and

Compliance: Non-Executive Independent Directors should keep governance and compliance with the applicable legislation and regulations under review and the conformity of ESCL practices to accepted norms.

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5. Status of Appointment

Further, you may be paid any remuneration if required as may be approved by the Board and the Shareholders from time to time.
- 5.2 The sitting fees presently paid to the Non-Executive Independent Director is Rs.5,000/- per meeting of the Board and Rs.2,000/- per meeting of Committee thereof.

6. Reimbursement of Expenses

In addition to the remuneration described in paragraph 5 the Company will, for the period of your appointment, will arrange for your travel and hotel bookings which are related to attending of Board and Committee Meetings.

7. Conflict of Interest
